Greetings,

I cannot believe it is July already. June was an amazing month with lots of things happening. I have shared pictures of all the events and performances that I was blessed to attend.

We have signed a new contract with Acton Academy for next year. We will be renting two rooms to accommodate the school's growth. I will need support to relocate items to alternate locations within the Church. The plan is to complete this project in mid-July. Please call the office if you would like to help me.

The Vestry and I have agreed to continue with Supply Priests until we have found a new Priest. We have been truly blessed to have the Supply Priests we have had and will continue to have as we go through the search process.

The Search Committee has been appointed and will be trained by Canon of the Ordinary Dan Smith in July. The search process was rewritten by Canon Dan Smith when he joined our Diocese. When I talked with Bishop Holcomb, he told me this is Canon Dan Smith's strength in Ministry. He will lead us through the training, and then the work will begin. We will send out a survey to all Members that will assist the search committee in identifying what we as a Church need.

I am asking each of you to pray the prayer found in the Book of Common Prayer, page 818, daily as we begin this process.


Memorial Garden Update

This is an update to last month's comments. I've included another drawing in case anyone missed it.

We are still waiting on the landscape architect to get the plan updated. At that time, we will resubmit and hopefully gain approval on the revised plan as well as installation of a Clusia screening shrub (approx. 300 linear feet).

After approval, I plan to bring a proposal to the Vestry for fill and sod at the entrance to make this area look more presentable and easily mowed. Lastly, I'm making plans with the Scouts to help us remove 3-4 invasive Schefflera trees from the preserve – these don't look bad but removal is required by the City. We will begin planting immediately after we get final approval.
